USE AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

SkunkShot is the latest and most effective cat and dog repellent on the market. SkunkShot utilizes the natural and non-toxic chemistry of the skunk in long lasting, waterproof granules, to provide a long term solution to problem cats and dogs and the mess they can make of your lawn or garden. Developed by Victoria University scientists, Skunkshot is a great dog and cat deterrent. SkunkShot is highly effective in protecting cars, boats, outdoor furniture etc. from scratch marks, paw prints and territorial "spraying".

Highly concentrated, SkunkShot comes in a handy 250ml bottle that is very easy to apply by simply scattering the granules around the problem area.

Skunkshot Scatter is highly effective in deterring cats and dogs from:

Gardens – Garbage Bags – Car Tyres – Aviaries – Fish Ponds

SKUNKSHOT SCATTER FEATURES INCLUDE:

Ease of application - Long Lasting (approx 3-4 weeks) – Highly concentrated
Weatherproof – Non Toxic –Developed from the natural chemistry of the highly odorous skunk.

Apply the Skunkshot scatter over the area you wish to protect. As a general rule, one teaspoon should cover an area of 1 sq metre.

Skunkshot is an outdoors product. Never open or use SkunkShot indoors. After use, keep the jar in the packaging supplied. The sachet will soak up any residual smell.

GARDEN USE

SkunkShot Scatter must be applied evenly to the whole area that is being protected, not just the border.

RUBBISH BAGS

Scatter a small amount around the base of your bag.

OTHER USES

Protecting car wheels from dog sprays, keeping cats off bonnets, protecting aviaries, nesting birds and garden fishponds.

Results for individual animals can vary. Deterrents may not be as effective against your own pets as they may associate the product with the owner.

After opening Skunkshot, the tube should be stored with the activated charcoal sachet provided in the screw top container. Dispose of used tube and container by wrapping in paper or plastic bag, and putting in the garbage bin.

If you accidentally get SkunkShot on your skin or clothing, first wash with soap and warm water. The smell can be neutralised by applying a weak solution of household bleach (a capful in half a bucket of water), and then rinsing with clean water.
